## COMMUNITY SUPPORTED SCHOOL MAINTENANCE PILOT PROGRAM QUICK START GUIDE

Working to improve the school building sanitation efforts at a school can be a daunting task. Before addressing the issues, it is important to understand the needs of your school, the regulations, and what steps are needed to develop an effective plan through sustainable control measures.
